Personal Information That May Be Collected

CAMBA collects personally identifiable information (PII) that may include your name, postal address, email address, phone number, facsimile number, credit/debit card information and billing information. Our primary purpose for soliciting this data is to process your donation/pledge. We may also use your PII for website registration, to respond to your request for information and/or communicate with you regarding your personal giving history. By submitting your personal information through our site, you give your consent for CAMBA's collection and use as described herein.

We are committed to keeping your information safe and secure. To this end, appropriate physical, electronic and managerial safeguards are in place to prevent unauthorized access as well as maintain data security. Our secure server comports with industry-standard Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology, which ensures the confidentiality of on-line transactions made on our website. SSL authentication and encryption prevents interception of your on-line information by third-parties. Although we take appropriate measures to safeguard against unauthorized disclosure of information, we cannot guarantee that your PII will never be disclosed in a manner that is inconsistent with this privacy policy.
